



PAWS 100 club rules

Purpose

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds for the Parents Association of Warwick School (PAWS). The money will be paid into the PAWS bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils. The 100 Club is classified as a Private Society Lottery under the Gambling Act 2005 and is only open to members of the Warwick School community.

Rules

1. Entry requires a one-off payment of £20 to cover all 10 draws in the academic year (October–July). Monthly payments are not accepted.. The maximum number of tickets sold will be 100.
2. To enter the draw participants must have purchased a ticket from the PAWS 100 Club People's Fundraising page. An email confirmation will be sent by People's Fundraising. PAWS will then email you your number between 1 and 100.
3. In the event of more than 100 participants wanting to join. Numbers will be allocated on a first come first served basis.
4. Payment must be made before the date of the first draw.
5. 10 draws will be made per academic year, starting in October. The draw will be on the first Monday of each month that the school is open. Draws will be conducted by a PAWS committee member in a public place (e.g. school office or hall), witnessed by at least one independent person.
6. 25% of the monthly income will be allocated to prizes each month. If all 100 tickets are sold, the monthly 1st prize will be £50. If fewer tickets are sold, the prize will be 25% of that month's income. There will be a single prize each month.
7. The 100 club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends Warwick School. You must be aged over 18 to enter.
8. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
9. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
10. The winner will be notified by email on the day of the draw using the email provided at sign-up. Winners will be asked for details so the payment can be made by BACS.
11. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted in the school newsletter. If you would prefer your name not to be mentioned please contact PAWS before the first draw.



12. The 100 club will be run by the PAWS. In case of any dispute the decision of the committee is final.
13. The 100 club will run between October 2025 and July 2026, all memberships will cease after the July draw. In the event that PAWS runs subsequent lotteries members will have to rejoin.
14. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into PAWS funds after six months.
15. Personal information provided (such as email and bank details) will be used solely for the administration of the 100 Club.
